<u>Head Gear</u>



There are three portions of the head gear that must be addressed; type, badge and plant badge.

Type

Black Glengarry with no dicing, red toorie (pom pom), black silk backing rosette, and black silk tails

Badge

Farquharson Clan Crest Badge Only! As per the desire of the Chief of Clan Farquharson

Note most vendors sell these items. Be sure of two things if purchasing from other than the recommended vendors:

- 1) The Demi-Lion actually looks like a lion
- 2.) The lion is on the Baronial chapeau (or hat)

The Crest that is shown is approved specifically by the Chief, the Standing Council of Scottish Chiefs and Lord Lyon

Plant Badge

The plant badge specifically for Clan Farquharson is Scots Fir. A sprig of Scots first should be attached to your Glengarry behind the Clan Crest Badge. Note: Scots Fir is also known as Scotch Pine and its scientific name is Pinus sylvestris. If you live in an area that it does not grow, then wearing an artificial sprig is allowed.
